Azalea Festival Beauty Pageant
Official Rules

- 1. Entrant must be a U.S. citizens and must be of good moral character; never been convicted of a crime, has any criminal charges pending against them, or has any adjudication pending against them. Entrants should not have engaged in any activities that are characterized as dishonest, immoral, or indecent. Entrant must have conduct becoming of a Queen at all times.**
- 2. Entrant must be a single female; never have been married, divorced, or had a marriage annulled. Entrant must have never been pregnant, nor may become pregnant or married during her reign.**
- 3. Any piercing, other than 2 ear lobe piercings, must be removed prior to pageant. If there is a navel piercing that can't be removed, a band-aid must be placed over it to tape it down.**
- 4. No visible tattoos or body art will be allowed.**
- 5. Entrant is required to attend all workshops and rehearsals.**
- 6. Entrant agrees to have the entry fee paid (whether through sponsor or parent). No refunds will be given for any reason.**

- 7. Entrant agrees the judges' decision is final.**
- 8. All grievances or objections relative to anything other than the actual contest will be referred to the Pageant Committee.**
- 9. Place all activities associated with the title of Azalea Festival Queen, above any and all other personal appearances. Exceptions can be made with approval in advance by the Pageant Coordinator.**

If chosen as a 2010 Queen in any category, the entrant agrees:

- 1. To be available at any time during the weekend of the Azalea Festival to serve as an official hostess of the event, a schedule will be provided to the Queen the night of the Pageant.**
- 2. Not to partake in any alcoholic beverages, smoking cigarettes, or using any illegal drugs, NO public fighting, swearing or nude photos while holding your newly earned title.**
- 3. To obtain approval in advance from the Pageant Coordinator for all personal appearances, as well as any photographic sessions and pictures released as an Azalea Queen.**
- 4. It is the responsibility of a parent or legal guardian of the Azalea Queen to provide all transportation to and from events during the weekend of the Azalea Festival and all other public appearances.**
- 5. Not to miss more than three events, without contacting the Pageant coordinator, emergencies only will be excused! Most events will be short notice please be prepared.**
- 6. You will need to have funds made available to supply your photo business cards, monogrammed Thank-you notes, and embroidered name on back of sash. If you are not capable to supply these funds, sponsorship is allowed for these expenses.**
- 7. To continue community service and civic involvement. As well as personal achievement.**
- 8. NO wearing of two crowns. You cannot compete in another pageant during your reign.**

9. Grade point averages are to not be lower than a 2.5. If you are having scholastic difficulties please get a tutor.

Royalty Demands and Contract:

The most important thing is to live a life that reflects your title, at all times!

You are now a public figure and eyes will be watching you.

Please be respectful of the title bestowed upon you. You were voted capable to handle

This is a mantle of leadership, so please don't disrespect yourself, or the judges who voted you worthy of this title.

Parades---It is your responsibility to ride in a carriage befitting a queen. You need to have handsomely made signs proclaiming your Festival, Title, Year, and Name clearly visible (Check with coordinator about this). If a vehicle is loaned from a dealership, please give recognition to that facility.

---When we use a float, be available to help decorate and donate items needed.

---Use sun-block, drink plenty of water!

--- Always be available to speak to the public about your title and the festival in which you represent.

---No selling of photos for profit.

Events---You will owe the Azalea Festival, time of public service during the festival, of your current reigning year. This will be scheduled with the Pageant Coordinator.

---Should an event come up that you would like to be a part of you need to get permission from the Pageant Coordinator, so it is not a conflict of interest. It has to meet the standards of a reigning Royalty.

---Should an invitation come and you are not able to participate in, we will need to get a letter of apology/thank you, out quickly.

---Invitations will come at short notice please always be ready with suitable attire, formal gown, ride, and Azalea Festival Queen Crown and Sash.

Grades: Please keep up your grades. Queens are not Dummies. Continue to read the newspaper and be informed on current events. If you are struggling in school get a tutor. At no time during your reign, will you drop out of school, or you will forfeit your title.

Responsibility: This experience is to develop responsibility and confidence. If you have a problem/ malfunction with your Crown, sash, or anything else you receive as Royalty, please call and let me know. But please be aware that you are now responsible for these items. If you break your crown or rip your sash, etc: YOU replace it NOT me or festival committee!!! Also you may be invited to be a guest, locally and around the state of Florida. You need to make sure there are funds available to you for such events.

MISC: Should you receive an invitation not through the Pageant Coordinator and would like to be a part, please contact the Coordinator for approval, with full details.

*Remember your manners, at all times. Please send thank you notes, after each parade, event, and invitation.

*If you would like to purchase personalized stationary for such situations that would be fine or you can speak to your Pageant Coordinator about official stationary.

If you feel at anytime you cannot meet or no longer wish to meet these demands, the title will be forfeited to the 1st runner up.
